COURSE CONTENT

Description:

Participants will develop a solid understanding of English language structures, engage in competent communication, and write brief texts and essays.

Through course materials, students will gain insights into British culture, history, and traditions, and by the end of the program, they will be able to read and discuss these topics. Students will learn to answer complex personal questions, talk about themselves in English, and ask detailed questions to others.

Throughout the course, participants will practice using English for interaction with peers, applying vocabulary and grammar structures taught in the lessons to develop more advanced communication skills.

Students will acquire a thorough understanding of grammar, including present, past, and future tenses, as outlined in the course book.

Participants will enhance their reading and pronunciation through regular reading exercises.

In addition, participants will engage in listening tasks that feature native English speakers, helping them improve their listening comprehension and pronunciation.

Aims and objectives:

- Participants will be able to understand the English language structures, communicate on a competent level and write short texts and essays.
- Participants will learn about British culture, history and customs through the course book and will be able to read and talk about it by the end of the course.

- Participants will be able to answer complex personal questions and talk about themselves as well as ask complex questions to others.
- Participants will communicate with each other in English and develop more complex communication skills by using vocabulary and grammar structures taught in class.
- Participants will learn the grammar structures as they are explained in the course book and will learn about the present, past and future tenses of the English language.
- Participants will read texts in English to develop their reading and pronunciation skills.
- Participants will have many listening comprehension tasks where they will hear native speakers which will help them develop comprehension skills as well as pronunciation.

Learning outcomes:

By the end of the course, participants will:

- Expand their vocabulary, grammar, and conversational abilities.
- Learn about British culture, history, and traditions.
- Be able to ask and respond to more complex questions in English.

Target group:

All levels of English

Minimum level of language: not required

Duration: 5 days (25 lessons / 45 min)

Schedule*



MONDAY	<p>Introduction and Initial Test: Overview of the course structure and objectives. Complete the entry-level test to assess participants' current English proficiency.</p> <p>Communication Skills: Engaging in basic communication activities to get familiar with conversational English.</p> <p>Course Materials: Introduction to the course book and resources.</p> <p>Reading Exercises: First set of reading exercises to develop comprehension and pronunciation.</p> <p>Communication Skills and Reading: Continue practicing conversational skills, followed by additional reading exercises for vocabulary building.</p> <p>Wrap-Up of the Day's Activities: Review and reinforce communication and reading skills covered earlier in the day. Address any questions about the course material or initial test results.</p>
TUESDAY	<p>Writing Exercises: Focus on crafting short texts such as descriptive paragraphs or simple essays. Emphasis on sentence structure, grammar, and vocabulary usage.</p> <p>Dialogue Reading: Practice reading dialogues in pairs or small groups to improve fluency, pronunciation, and understanding of conversational English.</p> <p>End-of-Day Review: Recap of the day's activities, addressing any challenges and reinforcing key learning points.</p>
WEDNESDAY	<p>Listening Exercises: Engage in listening comprehension activities with native speaker recordings. Focus on understanding key details, pronunciation, and conversational patterns.</p> <p>Brunch Preparation Activity: Participants will work together to prepare a simple brunch, using English to communicate throughout the process. This will involve discussing ingredients, giving and following instructions, and using practical vocabulary related to food and cooking.</p> <p>Brunch Together: While enjoying the meal, participants will continue to practice English in a relaxed, conversational setting. The focus will be on using everyday vocabulary, asking questions, and responding in complete sentences.</p>

THURSDAY	<p>Acting Out a Dialogue: Participants will be given a script or scenario to act out in pairs or small groups. This will focus on improving fluency, pronunciation, and intonation while practicing real-life conversational situations (e.g., ordering at a restaurant, asking for directions).</p> <p>Listening Skills Activity: Participants will listen to an audio recording or conversation and complete a table based on the information they hear. This task will focus on improving listening comprehension by identifying key details such as times, places, names, or other specific information. Q&A</p>
FRIDAY	<p>Reading and Writing Exercises: Participants will engage in reading activities followed by writing tasks. The focus will be on summarizing the text or writing a short essay related to the topic. This will reinforce reading comprehension, grammar, and writing skills.</p> <p>Reading and Writing Exercises: Begin the day with reading comprehension activities followed by writing tasks. Focus on summarizing a text or writing a short reflection to practice writing fluency and grammar.</p> <p>End-of-Course Test: Participants will complete a multiple-choice test assessing their progress in key areas such as vocabulary, grammar, reading, and listening.</p>

- the schedule describes likely activities but may be modified in accordance with the requests and needs of the participants;
- presentations of the participants' schools may be divided up and take place after the breaks on each day of the course.
